Tips for Secure Passwords We all want to protect information, and that often starts with a secure password. Here are a few tips to keep each of your passwords safe: Make each password long and strong. The more characters in your password, the stronger it is. Use multiple words to create a passphrase, such as "Don't forget to stand" or "stoppingwoods-snowy-evening." Create a unique password for each account. If you can't remember them all, ask if you can use a password manager. Keep passwords a secret. Never share them with anyone, including a supervisor.
